4 years on the Council. Took a special interest in children. Looks after disabled and vulnerable children. Has lived in Chapeltown and is moving back into the area.

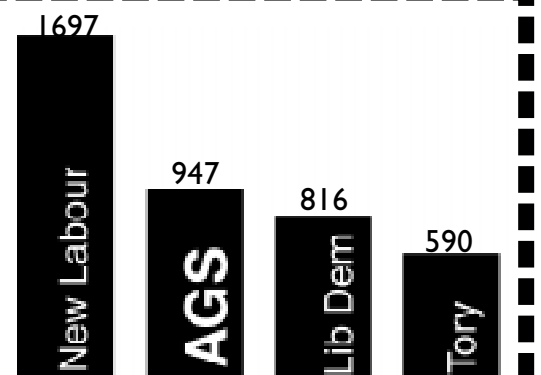
Beverley Samuels
